Arkansas Code 8-7-209 (b)(1)(E) is amended to read as 27 follows: 28 "(E) Establishing standards and procedures for the certification of 29 supervisory personnel at hazardous waste treatment or disposal facilities or sites as required under § 8-7-219(3) and contractors or consultants who are 30 31 engaged in work related to the investigation or remediation of hazardous 32 substance sites; and" 33 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 8-7-226(a) is amended to read as follows: 34 35 "(a) The commission shall have authority to establish by regulation a schedule of fees to recover the costs of processing permit applications and 36

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1	permit renewal proceedings, on-site inspections and monitoring, the
2	certification of personnel to operate hazardous waste treatment, storage, or
3	disposal facilities, and contractors or consultants investigating or
4	remediating hazardous substance sites, and other activities of department
5	personnel which are reasonably necessary to assure that generators and
6	transporters of hazardous waste and hazardous waste management facilities are
7	complying with the provisions of this subchapter, and which reasonably should
8	be borne by the transporter, generator, or owner or operator of the hazardous
9	waste management facility."
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11	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
12	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
13	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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15	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
16	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
17	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
18	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
19	act are declared to be severable.
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21	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
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
