All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed. SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-second General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that increases and clarification of new or additional positions at the various institutions of higher education are needed for the efficient and effective operations of the institutions. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill.
