22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-16-904(10) is repealed.

25 ~~(10) State Board of Optometry;~~

27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 25-16-905 is amended to read as follows:

28 "25-16-905. Stipend - Authorization for \$100.

29 Each of the following state boards may, by a majority vote of the total
30 membership of the board cast during its first regularly scheduled meeting of
31 each calendar year, authorize payment to its members of a stipend not to
32 exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) per meeting attended, and the board members
33 shall receive no other compensation, expense reimbursement, or in-lieu-of
34 payments except as provided in § 25-16-902:

35 (1) Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners; ~~and~~

36 (2) Arkansas State Medical Board; and

1 (3) State Board of Optometry."

3 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
4 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
5 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11 act are declared to be severable.

13 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
14 hereby repealed.
