"AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT WHICH ORIGINATED AS SENATE
BILL 368 OF 1999 TO PROVIDE A MAXIMUM SURCHARGE WHICH
MAY BE LEVIED BY THAT ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 7(a) of the act of 1999 which originated as Senate
Bill 368 of 1999 is amended to read as follows:

"(a) A surcharge in the amount of fifty cents (.50) per each one
thousand dollars (\$1,000) of construction authorized on any non-residential
construction permit issued by any political subdivision of this state is
imposed to financially support the craft training education program. The
maximum surcharge for any construction project permitted shall be one thousand
dollars (\$1,000)."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
