- 9 (c) The committee shall be assisted by staff provided by the Bureau of 10 Legislative Research.
 - (d) Members of the committee shall be entitled to receive per diem and expenses for their attendance at committee meetings at the same rate as members of the General Assembly receive for attendance of interim committees.
 - (e) The members appointed to the committee shall select a Senate cochairman and a House cochairman who shall serve for a two-year term during the interim."

- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 10-3-1602 is amended to read as follows:
- 19 "10-3-1602. Duties.
 - The duties of the Joint Interim Oversight Committee on Higher Education Reform shall include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - (1) Reviewing the Office of Accountability in the Department of Higher Education Reviewing policy issues regarding the creation and implementation of acceptability systems for the state system of education, including the review of any regulatory changes proposed by the appropriate agencies of the executive branch or any boards or commissions prior to their implementation;
 - (2) Reviewing policy issues affecting postsecondary educational reform on or before November 15 of the year preceding a regularly scheduled legislative session and making recommendations concerning any necessary legislative changes proposed by the Department of Higher Education or the State Board of Higher Education school districts, cooperatives, institutions of higher education, the Department of Education, the State Board of Education, the Department of Workforce Education, the State Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities, the Department of Higher Education, the
