## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO PERMIT PERSONS WHO HAVE SERVED AS SHERIFF  
10 FOR A MINIMUM OF SIX (6) YEARS TO SERVE AS A LAW  
11 ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL WITHOUT HAVING TO TAKE TRAINING  
12 COURSES IN LAW ENFORCEMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "TO PERMIT PERSONS WHO HAVE SERVED AS  
16 SHERIFF FOR A MINIMUM OF SIX (6) YEARS  
17 TO SERVE AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL  
18 WITHOUT HAVING TO TAKE TRAINING COURSES  
19 IN LAW ENFORCEMENT."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23  
24 SECTION 1. Any person who has held the office of sheriff for a minimum  
25 of six (6) years may be employed as a law enforcement officer without having  
26 to take any training courses in law enforcement.

27  
28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31  
32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
36 act are declared to be severable.

2           SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
3 hereby repealed.
