## For An Act To Be Entitled

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9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 6-18-1005 TO PROVIDE  
10 INDIVIDUALIZED HEALTH CARE PLANS FOR STUDENTS WITH  
11 SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

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14 "TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 6-18-1005 TO  
15 PROVIDE INDIVIDUALIZED HEALTH CARE PLANS  
16 FOR STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE  
17 NEEDS."

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-18-1005(a)(6) is hereby amended to read as  
23 follows:

24 "(6) Health services; and which shall include, but are not limited to,  
25 the following:

26 (A) Students with special health care needs, including  
27 chronically ill, medically fragile and technology dependent, and students with  
28 other health impairments shall have an individualized health care plan;

29 (B) Invasive medical procedures required by students and provided  
30 at the school shall be performed by trained, licensed medical personnel;

31 (C) Custodial health services required by students shall be  
32 provided by trained school employees other than the classroom teachers; and"

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34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
