6	(c) The prosecuting attorney may revoke the appointment of a special				
7	prosecuting attorney under this subchapter at any time.				
8	(d) Nothing in this section shall obligate the Attorney General to				
9	provide an attorney for purposes of assisting the prosecuting attorney in				
10	criminal actions designated in subsection (b) of this section, and nothing in				
11	this section shall prevent the Attorney General from withdrawing from				
12	participation in such cases at any time."

14	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature				
15	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code				
16	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

18	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to				
19	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect				
20	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without				
21	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this				
22	act are declared to be severable.

24	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are				
25	hereby repealed.
