

10	TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER RELATING TO THE NATURAL RESOURCES	
11	DAMAGES TRUST FUND; TO CREATE A NATURAL RESOURCES

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
21		
22	SECTION 1. Title 8 of the Arkansas Code is amended to add the following	J
23	new chapter:	
24	" <u>8-11-101. Title.</u>	
25	This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the 'Natural Resources	
26	Damages Trust Fund Act.'	
27		
28	<u>8-11-102. Definitions.</u>	
29	As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:	
30	(1) 'Advisory Board' means the Natural Resources Damages Advisory Board	<u>;</u>
31	(2) 'Fund' means the Natural Resources Damages Trust Fund created by	
32	this chapter; and	
33	<u>(3) 'Natural resources' means land, fish, wildlife, biota, air, surface</u>	<u>9</u>
34	water, ground water, drinking water supplies, and other such resources	
35	<u>belonging to, managed by, held in trust by, appertaining to, or otherwise</u>	
36	controlled by the State of Arkansas or local government.	



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2	8-11-103. Natural Resources Damages Trust Fund.
3	(a)(1) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State,
4	Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to be
5	known as the 'Natural Resources Damages Trust Fund.'
6	(2) In addition to all moneys appropriated by the General Assembly to
7	the fund, there shall be deposited in the fund all payments collected by the
8	state for restoration, rehabilitation, replacement, or acquisition of natural
9	resources and any moneys received by the state as a gift or donation to the
10	fund or any federal moneys designated to enter the fund, and all interest
11	earned upon moneys deposited in the fund.
12	(3) All moneys received into the fund shall be utilized for natural
13	resource restoration, rehabilitation, replacement, or acquisition.
14	(b) All expenditures from the fund shall be authorized by the Natural
15	Resources Damages Trust Advisory Board, according to the provisions of this
16	chapter and the requirements or conditions of any orders, settlement
17	agreements, gifts, or donations.
18	
19	8-11-104. Natural Resources Damages Advisory Board.
20	There is hereby created and established a Natural Resources Damages
21	Advisory Board.
22	(a) The Advisory Board shall be composed of seven (7) members:
23	(1) One (1) member shall be a representative from the Arkansas Farm
24	Bureau Federation, Inc.;
25	(2)One (1) member shall be a representative from the Arkansas Soil and
26	<u>Water Conservation Commission;</u>
27	(3) One (1) member shall be a representative from the State Forestry
28	<u>Commission;</u>
29	(4) One (1) member shall be a representative from the Arkansas
30	<u>Department of Environmental Quality;</u>
31	(5) One (1) member shall be a representative from the Arkansas State
32	<u>Game and Fish Commission;</u>
33	(6) One (1) member shall be a representative of the Arkansas Natural
34	Heritage Commission; and
35	(7) One (1) member shall be a representative of the Attorney General's
36	Office.

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1	(b) Members of the Advisory Board shall serve without compensation.
2	(c) The Advisory Board shall have the following powers and duties:
3	(1) To develop projects for the restoration, rehabilitation,
4	replacement, and acquisition of natural resources;
5	(2) To request proposals for natural resource related projects;
6	(3) To review and evaluate proposals for natural resource related
7	proj ects;
8	(4) To select projects for the restoration, rehabilitation,
9	replacement, and acquisition of natural resources; and
10	(5) To approve payments from the Natural Resources Damages Trust Fund
11	for projects and other activities relating to the restoration, rehabilitation,
12	replacement, and acquisition of natural resources.
13	
14	8-11-105. Duties of the Department of Finance and Administration.
15	(a) The Department of Finance and Administration shall administer the
16	fund, as authorized by the Advisory Board.
17	(b) The Department of Finance and Administration shall undertake the
18	following activities, as authorized by the Advisory Board:
19	(1) Develop and issue requests for proposals;
20	(2) Award grants for projects relating to natural resource restoration,
21	rehabilitation, replacement, and acquisition;
22	(3) Contract for services; and
23	(4) Make payments from the Natural Resources Damages Trust Fund."
24	
25	SECTION 2. If another act of the 1999 Regular Session of the General
26	Assembly adds a new Chapter 11 to Title 8 of the Arkansas Code, the Arkansas
27	Code Revision Commission may renumber the chapter, and its sections, added by
28	this act.
29	
30	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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34	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
36	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

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1	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this	5
2	act are declared to be severable.	
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4	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are	
5	hereby repealed.	
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
