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1 (b) The resource center may provide vocational -technical educational 2 programs and services which the State Board of Vocational Education Work 3 Force Education and Career Opportunities may approve or which school districts or other vocational, technical, or adult programs may support with local 4 funds." 5 6 7 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 6-51-1008 (c) is amended to read as follows: 8 "(c) Categorical state or federal funds may be assigned to the resource 9 center upon approval of its board of directors and under conditions set by the State Board of Vocational Education Work Force Education and Career 10 Opportunities or the State Board of Education." 11 12 13 SECTION 6.
