SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>CARRY</u> FORWARD. Any balance remaining in the appropriation and funds made available for the State Alcohol Program which remains on June 30, 1999 or June 30, 2000 or both may be carried forward into the next fiscal year, there to be used for the same purpose.

33 SECTION 4. <u>All outstanding encumbrances of the Community Alcohol Safety</u> 34 Program as of June 30, 1999, shall be paid by the Arkansas Department of

35 <u>Health with Community Alcohol Safety Program funds.</u>

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1	SECTION 5. All personnel transferred from the Arkansas State Highway			
2	and Transportation Department pursuant to Section 1 of this Act shall be
