22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-16-801(a)(2) is amended to read as follows:

25 "(2) Each license shall include:

26 (A) A distinguishing number assigned to the licensee;

27 (B) The name, residence address (if the licensee is a law
28 enforcement officer, at the officer's option the license shall disclose a post
29 office box in lieu of the residence address), date of birth, and a brief
30 description of the licensee; and

31 (C) A space upon which the licensee may affix his
32 signature."

34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
