21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-4-109 is amended by adding a new subsection
24 to be appropriately lettered by the Arkansas Code Revision Commission:

25 "County Boards of Election Commissioners, election officials and
26 election monitors shall attend mandatory election training provided by the
27 State Board of Election Commissioners. The State Board of Election
28 Commissioners shall determine the method and amount of compensation."
29

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
33

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
5 hereby repealed.
