## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A PORTION OF CROOKED CREEK AS AN  
10 EXTRAORDINARY RESOURCE WATER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 "TO DESIGNATE A PORTION OF CROOKED CREEK  
14 AS AN EXTRAORDINARY RESOURCE WATER."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 15-57-310(f) is amended to read as follows:

20 "(f)(1) The mining of gravel or other materials from streams or stream  
21 beds shall comply with the permitting requirements of this subchapter.

22 (2) There shall be no mining in streams designated as extraordinary  
23 resource waters of the state, as established by law in water quality standards  
24 duly promulgated by the commission for all surface waters of the State of  
25 Arkansas.

26 (3) That portion of Crooked Creed beginning at its origin in northern  
27 Newton County and flowing north and east across the southeast corner of Boone  
28 County and southern Marion County and ending at its confluence with the White  
29 River near Cotter is hereby designated an extraordinary resource water for the  
30 purposes of this section."  
31

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
35

36 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
4 act are declared to be severable.

5  
6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
7 hereby repealed.
