21 WHEREAS, Section 17 of Article V of the Constitution of the State of
22 Arkansas provides that the regular biennial session of the General Assembly
23 shall not exceed sixty days in duration, unless extended by a vote of two-
24 thirds of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly; and

25 WHEREAS, it now appears that the regular session of the Eighty-second
26 General Assembly will be unable to complete the essential business of this
27 session within sixty days, and that an extension of this regular session will
28 be necessary for the completion of the business of this session;

29 NOW THEREFORE,

30 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
31 STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

32 THAT the regular session of the Eighty-Second General Assembly of the
33 State of Arkansas is hereby extended through the close of business in each
34 house on Thursday, March 25, 1999, at which time the regular session shall be
35 adjourned sine die unless it is determined that a further extension is
36 necessary to complete the business of the session.
