WHEREAS, the Bal anced Budget Act of 1997 resulted in the rei mbursement for physical therapy and speech therapy to be subject to a cap of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500) per year per patient for both physical therapy and speech therapy conbi ned; and

WHEREAS, occupational therapy was segregated with a separate fifteen hundred dollar ( $\$ 1,500$ ) per year cap; and

WHEREAS, combi ni ng physi cal therapy and speech therapy toget her under the sarre cap appears unreasonable;

NOW THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EI GHTY- SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATI VES CONCURRI NG THEREI N:

THAT the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Arkansas General Assembly respectfully request the Congress of the United States to revi ew the restrictions placed by the Bal anced Budget Act of 1997 on rei mbursement for rehabilitation expenses for purposes of
(1) Determining whether physical therapy and speech therapy should have separate maxi mums for rei mbursement; and
(2) Whether the existing maximuns are adequate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this resol ution, the Secretary of the Senate should forward an authenticated copy hereof to the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, each member of Arkansas' Congressional Del egation, and the Administrator of the Feder al Health Care Fi nance Administration.
