WHEREAS, school buildings in the State of Arkansas are deteriorating and as a result affect the Iearning environment of our children; and

WHEREAS, we need to ensure that our chil dren have the optimulearning envi ronment in order to become educated and successful adults; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas General Assenbly may find resources available to assist public schools in repairing the school buildings.

NOW THEREFORE,
be IT resolved by the senate of the el ghty- second general assembly of the STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATI VES CONCURRI NG THEREI N:

That the Legislative Council study the issue of the stat us and condition of public school buildings in the state. The Legislative Council shall create a subcomittee to conduct hearings throughout the state to view the public school buil dings and to gather information fromteachers, students, parents and citizens of the commities. The subcomittee shall provide a
recomendation to the Legislative Council upon concl usion of the hearings. The subcomittee shall be comprised of $t$ wel ve members to consist of
(1) Six (6) members of the Legislative Council appointed by the cochai rmen of the Legislative Council;
(2) Three (3) members of the Senate InterimComittee on Education to be appointed by the Chairman of the Senate Interim Committee on Education; and
(3) Three (3) menbers of the House InterimComittee on Education to be appointed by the Chairman of the House Interim Committee on Education.
