24 WHEREAS, Mr. Bill Smith was legal advisor to several Arkansas  
25 governors; Mr. Frank Story was Secretary of the State Board of Finance for  
26 many years; and Mr. Julian Hogan was Director of the Office of Budget and  
27 Preaudit of the State Comptroller's Office and one of the leading fiscal  
28 authorities in state government for many years; and

29 WHEREAS, Mr. Smith, Mr. Story, and Mr. Hogan were the architects of the  
30 Arkansas Revenue Stabilization Law which was enacted in 1945 during the  
31 administration of Governor Ben Laney; and

32 WHEREAS, the Revenue Stabilization Law is a unique financial tool  
33 designed to assure that state spending is consistent with state revenue  
34 collections, and it has in the past and continues to successfully accomplish  
35 that admirable purpose; and

36 WHEREAS, it is most appropriate that the new revenue building on the

1 State Capitol grounds be named the Smith-Story-Hogan Taxpayer Services Center,  
2 in honor of Mr. Bill Smith, Mr. Frank Story, and Mr. Julian Hogan,

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4 NOW THEREFORE,

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
6 STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

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8 The General Assembly hereby urges the Department of Finance and  
9 Administration to name the new Revenue Division Taxpayer Service Building the  
10 Smith-Story-Hogan Taxpayer Services Center, and to cause appropriate signs to  
11 be installed on the building to display that name.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this Resolution, the  
14 Secretary of the Senate shall transmit a copy hereof to the Director of the  
15 Department of Finance and Administration.
