

22	WHEREAS, the citizens of Arkansas have expressed interest in having
23	daylight savings time remain in effect year-round; and
24	WHEREAS, due to the mobility of our society and extent of interstate
25	commerce, it appears desirable to maintain the same time year-round; and
26	WHEREAS, to accomplish such requires action by the United States
27	Congress;

29	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL
30	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING
31	THEREIN:

33	That the United States Congress is requested to conduct a study of the
34	feasibility and desirability of adopting legislation to provide that either
35	daylight savings time or standard time remain in effect year-round.
