9	"REQUESTING THE APPROPRIATE SENATE INTERIM COMMITTEE

18	FAIR HOUSING LAW AND THE NEED FOR A
19	STATEWIDE FAIR HOUSING COMMITTEE."

22	WHEREAS, the federal government enacted the federal fair housing laws in
23	the 1960's to assure that fair and equal housing opportunities are available
24	to all persons in Arkansas and throughout the United States, and extensive
25	federal regulations and statutes and case law have sprung up around those fair
26	housing laws providing procedures for enforcement; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, the Arkansas General Assembly enacted the Arkansas Fair Housing
29	Act, Act 1327 of 1995, giving all Arkansas citizens the opportunity to obtain
30	housing and other real estate without discrimination because of religion,
31	race, color, national origin, sex, disability, or familial status and has
32	recognized and declared fair housing to be a civil right; and
33	
34	WHEREAS, since Arkansas' law was only recently enacted and since the
35	federal laws have been in existence for many years, it is possible that
36	changes may be needed for consistency in Arkansas law when compared to the

federal law, and that some statewide board or commission might be needed to provide oversight for the goals of fair and equal housing opportunities for all persons in Arkansas, NOW THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: That the Arkansas Legislative Council is asked to refer this request to the appropriate interim committee of the Arkansas Senate to conduct a study of the Arkansas Fair Housing law and the feasibility of creating a Statewide Fair Housing Committee and to determine if there is a need to change the laws and create the body to better serve the needs of all people in Arkansas, and that the committee report their recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the Eighty-third General Assembly.
