20 WHEREAS, Mr. Fred Henne of Little Rock, Arkansas, died March 20, 1999,
21 in Tuebingen, Germany, at the age of 73 years; and

22
23 WHEREAS, Mr. Fred Henne was the son of Fritz and Rosa Henne, both of
24 whom immigrated to the United States in 1922; and

25
26 WHEREAS, Mr. Fred Henne served in the United States Army during World
27 War II and after his discharge he joined the Army Reserves where he achieved
28 the rank of Colonel; and

30 WHEREAS, Mr. Henne attended law school both in Little Rock and at the
31 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville and after he received his law degree, he
32 entered state service where he served for approximately 32 years; and

34 WHEREAS, Mr. Henne's state service included 15½ years with the
35 Department of Public Welfare (now the Department of Human Services) and 16½
36 years as the Director of the Public Employees Retirement System; and

1 WHEREAS, in his position as Director of the Arkansas Public Employees
2 Retirement System, Mr. Henne had occasion to appear before the Arkansas
3 General Assembly and its committees on several occasions; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Henne was a member of the First Lutheran Church in Little
6 Rock and a member of Big Rock Lodge No. 622; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Henne was not only a capable and dedicated state employee,
9 he was also active in church and civic affairs; and

11 WHEREAS, it is most fitting that this body publicly recognize and
12 memorialize Mr. Henne's lifetime of dedicated service to his state and local
13 community and to his fellowman,

15 NOW THEREFORE,

16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
17 STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 This Resolution is adopted in respectful memory of Mr. Fred Henne and in
20 recognition of his many years of dedicated public service to the State of
21 Arkansas, to his local community and to his fellowman.
