26	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas

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2 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 3 TRANSFERS. lf 4 the Speaker of the House and the Coordinator of House Legislative Services 5 determine that any item or portion thereof appropriated herein for a specific 6 purpose is not needed for such purposes, they may certify such fact to the 7 State Auditor, and the State Auditor shall cause transfer to be made from one 8 item to another.

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10 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 11 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USES OF 12 APPROPRIATION. The funds appropriated in this Act shall be used to defray the 13 expenses of the House of Representatives of the Regular Session of the Eighty-14 Second Eighty-third General Assembly, and upon adjournment of the Regular 15 Session, any unexpended balance of the funds appropriated in this Act may be 16 used to defray the necessary expenses of the operation of the Office of the 17 Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Office of the Coordinator of 18 House Legislative Services, the Office of Parliamentarian, the Chief Clerk's 19 Office, House Constituency Services Office and other reasonable and necessary 20 expenses of the House of Representatives of the Eighty-Second Eighty-third 21 General Assembly incurred during the interim between the adjournment of the 22 Regular Session of the Eighty-Second Eighty-third General Assembly and July 1,-23 1999 July 1, 2001.

Additionally, if it is determined by the Speaker of the House that the presence, assistance, oversight and expertise of any House member is needed in the interim between the regular sessions, and if it is determined by the Speaker of the House that certain expenses and per diem of members of the House should be paid by the House, such expenses and per diem at the rate authorized for attending legislative sessions shall be paid from the funds appropriated herein for Maintenance, Operations and Expenses.

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32 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 33 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARY LEVELS. 34 The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Coordinator of House 35 Legislative Services shall, during the month of June, 1999 and 20002001 and 36 2002, meet and determine the actual salaries to be paid each employee

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beginning the following July 1. Such salaries of the employees will be based upon an evaluation of the performance of the Coordinator of House Legislative Services by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and upon an evaluation of the performance of the other employees by the Coordinator of House Legislative Services.

6 The Parliamentarian of the House of Representatives may be paid a per diem 7 up to such amount as is authorized for members of the General Assembly each 8 day the General Assembly is in regular or extraordinary session. The 9 Coordinator of House Legislative Services and the Parliamentarian may be provided an expense allowance up to such amount as is authorized for 10 11 reimbursable expenses for members of the General Assembly. Such per diem 12 shall be paid from the appropriation provided in Section 1 of this Act. The 13 expense allowance and associated personal services matching costs, if any, are 14 to be paid from the appropriations for Personal Services provided in the 15 biennial appropriation act for personal services and operating expenses for 16 the Arkansas House of Representatives for the applicable fiscal year.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

Assembly, that the House of Representatives of the 83rd General Assembly
 convenes in regular session on January 8, 2001; that expenses of the session

21 begin immediately; and that the expenses are a just expense of state which

22 must be paid at the time the services are provided. Therefore, an emergency is

23 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate

24 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and

25 <u>effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.</u>

26 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become

27 <u>effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor</u>

28 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is

29 <u>overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the</u>
30 veto.

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
