Arkansas Code 21-8-402(5)(B), which provides the definition 24 25 of gift for the purpose of ethics provisions, is amended to read as follows: 26 (B) The term "gift" does not include: 27 (i)(a) Informational material such as books, reports, pamphlets, calendars, or periodicals informing a public servant regarding his 28 29 or her official duties; 30 (b) Payments for travel or reimbursement for any 31 expenses are not informational material; (ii) The giving or receiving of food, lodging, or travel 32 33 which bears a relationship to the public servant's office and when appearing 34 in an official capacity; 35 (iii) Gifts which are not used and which, within thirty 36 (30) days after receipt, are returned to the donor;

21	received, or to be received as a claim for future services, whether in the
22	form of a retainer, fee, salary, expense, allowance, forbearance, forgiveness,
23	interest, dividend, royalty, rent, or any other form of recompense or any
24	combination thereof;
25	(B) The term "compensation" does not include anything of value
26	presented to an employee of a public school district, the Arkansas School for
27	the Blind, the Arkansas School for the Deaf, the Arkansas School for
28	Mathematics and Science, a university, a college, a technical college, a
29	technical institute, a comprehensive life-long learning center, or a community
30	college in recognition of the employee's contribution to education;
