AN ACT TO TRANSFER THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE
CAPITOL ZONING DISTRICT COMMISSION TO THE CITY OF
LITTLE ROCK; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO TRANSFER THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE
CAPITOL ZONING DISTRICT COMMISSION TO
THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Capitol Zoning District Commission is abolished and all
of its powers, duties, and functions are transferred to the city of Little
Rock.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 22-3-303 is repealed.

~~(a) There is created and established at the seat of government a
commission to be known as the "Capitol Zoning District Commission".~~

~~(b) The commission shall have nine (9) members, as follows:~~

~~(1) The Governor, or his designee, who shall be chairman;~~

~~(2) The Secretary of State, or his designee;~~

~~(3) Four (4) resident electors of this state, to be designated by
the Governor and who shall serve three year terms, one (1) of whom shall be a
black;~~

~~(4) The Director of the City Planning staff of the City of Little
Rock, or his designee;~~

1 ~~(5) One (1) resident elector of this state who shall be a~~
2 ~~resident of and an owner of property within the Governor's Mansion area of the~~
3 ~~Capitol Zoning District, to be designated by the Governor, and who shall serve~~
4 ~~a three-year term; and~~

5 ~~(6) One (1) resident elector of this state who shall be an owner~~
6 ~~of property or the designee of an owner of property within the State Capitol~~
7 ~~area of the Capitol Zoning District, to be designated by the Governor, and who~~
8 ~~shall serve a three-year term.~~

9 ~~(c) The Director of the Capitol Zoning District Commission shall serve~~
10 ~~as the disbursing officer for the Capitol Zoning District Commission.~~

11 ~~(d) Members of the commission shall receive no pay for their services,~~
12 ~~but may receive expense reimbursement and stipends in accordance with § 25-16-~~
13 ~~901 et seq.~~

14 ~~(e)(1) The Capitol Zoning District Commission is authorized to employ a~~
15 ~~director and such other staff as the commission deems appropriate and within~~

17 ~~(2) The commission shall have the authority to enter into~~
18 ~~contracts of any lawful nature, and to do any and all acts necessary to effect~~
