14 SERVICE IN ANY STATE-SUPPORTED RETIREMENT SYSTEM; AND

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 24-3-102(12)(C) is amended to read as follows:

29 (C) For a member with credited service for employment as a public
30 safety employee or as a sheriff, age sixty-five (65) reduced by one (1) month
31 for each two (2) months of such credited service, but in no event to an age
32 younger than fifty-five (55), except in the case of members of the State
33 Police Retirement System and sheriffs who have a minimum of ten (10) years of
34 actual service as a sheriff or who have eight (8) years of actual service as a
35 sheriff and a minimum of two (2) years of service in ~~another~~ any state-
36 supported retirement system, for whom the minimum retirement age shall be

1 fi fty-two (52);
