1	(1) Three (3) members appointed by the Governor;
2	(2) Three (3) members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of
3	the Senate; and
4	(3) Three (3) members appointed by the Speaker of the House of

6	(b) Members of the committee shall not be entitled to compensation for
7	their services but may receive expense reimbursement in accordance with
