Arkansas Code 23-79-701 is amended to read as follows: 23 23-79-701. Definitions. 24 As used in this subchapter: 25 (1) "Health care services" means any services included in the 26 furnishing to any individual of medical or hospitalization or services 27 incident to the furnishing of care or hospitalization, as well as the furnishing to any person of any and all other services or goods for the 28 29 purpose of preventing, alleviating, curing, or healing human illness or 30 i nj ury; (2) "Health plan" means any group, blanket, or individual disability 31 32 insurance policy, contract, or plan issued in this state by an insurance 33 company, hospital medical service corporation, or health maintenance organization, provided that nothing in this subchapter shall apply to accident 34 35 only, specified disease, hospital indemnity, Medicare supplement, long-term 36 care, disability income, or other limited benefit health insurance policies;

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1	(3) "Inherited metabolic disease" means a disease caused by an
2	inherited abnormality of body chemistry;
3	(4) "Low protein modified food product" means a food product that is
4	specifically formulated to have less than one (1) gram of protein per serving
5	and intended to be used under the direction of a physician for the dietary
6	treatment of an inherited metabolic disease;

- (5) "Medical food" means a food that is intended for the dietary treatment of a disease or condition for which nutritional requirements are established by recognized scientific principles and formulated to be consumed or administered enterally under the direction of a physician; and
- (6) "Provider" means any person who is licensed in this state to furnish health care services as a health professional.
