22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-62-102(a) is amended to read as follows:

25 (a)(1) Whenever the death of a person or viable fetus shall be
26 caused by a wrongful act, neglect, or default and the act, neglect, or default
27 is such as would have entitled the party injured to maintain an action and
28 recover damages in respect thereof, if death had not ensued, then, and in
29 every such case, the person who, or company, or corporation which would have
30 been liable if death had not ensued shall be liable to an action for damages,
31 notwithstanding the death of the person or viable fetus injured, and although
32 the death may have been caused under such circumstances as amount in law to a
33 felony.

34 (2) The cause of action created in this subsection shall survive
35 the death of the person wrongfully causing the death of another and may be
36 brought, maintained, or revived against the personal representatives of the

1 person wrongfully causing the death of another.

2 (3) No person shall be liable under this subsection (a) when the
3 death of the fetus results from a legal abortion or from the fault of the
4 pregnant woman carrying the fetus.
