Arkansas Code 27-37-702 is amended to read as follows: Seat belt use required - Applicability of subchapter. 24 27-37-702. 25 (a) Each driver and front seat passenger in any motor vehicle operated 26 on a street or highway in this state shall wear a properly adjusted and 27 fastened seat belt. (b) This subchapter Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to 28 29 the following: (1) Passenger automobiles manufactured before July 1, 1968, and 30 31 all other motor vehicles manufactured before January 1, 1972; 32 (2) Passengers and drivers with a physical disability which contraindicates the use of a seat belt, and which condition is certified by a 33 physician who states the nature of the disability, as well as the reason the 34 35 use of a seat belt is inappropriate; 36 (3) Children under five (5) years of age who require protection

1	under the Child Passenger Protection Act, § 27-34-101 et seq.; and
2	(4) Drivers who are rural letter carriers of the United States
3	Postal Service while performing their duties as rural letter carriers.
4	(c) The driver, front seat passengers, and other passengers in any
5	school bus operated on a street or highway of this state shall wear a properly
6	adjusted and fastened seat belt whenever the school bus is so equipped.
7	(d) The state, county, a school district, school bus operator, or agent
8	or employee of a school district or school bus operator, including a teacher
9	or volunteer serving as a chaperone, shall not be liable in any action for
10	personal injury by a school bus passenger for an injury caused solely by
11	another passenger's use or non-use of a safety belt or restraint system in a
12	dangerous or unsafe manner.
13	SECTION 2. (a) For purposes of this section, "seat belt" means any
14	passenger restraint system as defined by the rules and regulations of the
15	Arkansas State Police.
16	(b) All school buses purchased after January 1, 2003, shall be equipped
17	with three-point retractable seat belts on every seat.
