BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) For purposes of this section, "state agency" means every department, division, office, board, commission, and institution of this state, excluding state-supported institutions of higher education.

(b) Every state agency that receives grants in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) from any source shall report to the Legislative Council within forty-five (45) calendar days after receipt of a grant.

(c) The report shall include:

(1) The amount of the grant;

(2) The purpose of the grant;

(3) The source of the grant;

(4) Conditions of the grant; and

(5) Any other information requested by the Legislative Council.

SECTION 2. All state-supported institutions of higher education shall continue to report grants to the Department of Finance and Administration

1 quarterly on forms prescribed by the Department of Finance and Administration
2 and the Department of Finance and Administration shall upon receipt thereof
3 file the same with the Legislative Council.
