## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS FOR  
LICENSED ELECTRICIANS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO REQUIRE CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS  
FOR LICENSED ELECTRICIANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 28, Subchapter 3 is amended  
by adding an additional section to read as follows:

17-28-311. Continuing education requirements.

(a) No license shall be renewed unless the licensee has completed at  
least six (6) hours of continuing education a year.

(b)(1) The continuing education courses shall be established and  
approved by the Board of Electrical Examiners of the State of Arkansas.

(2) The continuing education hours required under subsection (a)  
of this section shall include requirements of the National Electrical Code  
existing on January 1, 2001 that have been adopted by the board.
