For An Act To Be Entitled

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10 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 8-6-609 AND 8-6-610 TO
11 CHANGE THE RECYCLING GRANTS REPORTING PERIOD TO THE
12 STATE FISCAL YEAR; TO CLARIFY THE REGULATORY
13 REQUIREMENTS OF RECYCLING GRANT RECIPIENTS; AND FOR
14 OTHER PURPOSES.

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17 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 8-6-609
18 AND 8-6-610 TO CHANGE THE RECYCLING
19 GRANTS REPORTING PERIOD TO THE STATE
20 FISCAL YEAR; TO CLARIFY THE REGULATORY
21 REQUIREMENTS OF RECYCLING GRANT

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 8-6-609(d) is amended to read as follows:

27 (d)(1)(A) The department shall prepare an annual progress report on
28 grant assistance made under this section.

29 (B) The report shall include:

30 (i) The amount of each grant;

31 (ii) The purpose of the grant;

32 (iii) How grant funds were expended by the applicant;

33 (iv) The results produced or the progress made on the
34 project; and

35 (v) The revenues produced and tonnages of materials
36 collected by the project.

1 (C) The report for each ~~calendar~~ state fiscal year shall be
2 filed by ~~July~~ November 1 of the following fiscal year with the office of the
3 Governor and the Legislative Council.

4 (D) The report shall include information on grant
5 recipients for a period of five (5) years from the date of disbursement of
6 funds by the department.

7 (2)(A) Regional solid waste management boards shall provide the
8 department with a report summarizing:

- 9 (i) Progress in the project;
- 10 (ii) Expenditures from the grant award;
- 11 (iii) Tonnages of materials collected by the project;
- 12 and
- 13 (iv) Revenues produced by the sale of materials

14 collected.

15 (B) The report shall be filed annually on or before ~~April 1~~
16 September 1.

17 (C) Failure by a board to file the required reports shall
18 provide grounds for the department to withhold disbursement of grant funds for
19 subsequent grant rounds.

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21 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 8-6-610(c) is amended to read as follows:

22 (c) If, within a three-year period beginning on the date that the
23 department awards the grant, the grantee does not meet the conditions of the
24 grant prescribed under subsection (b) of this section, and the regulations
25 promulgated under authority of this chapter, the department may order the
26 grantee to reimburse the department for up to one hundred percent (100%) of
27 the grant according to the following schedule:

28 (1) If the grantee fails to meet the conditions in the first year
29 after the grant award, the grantee may be required to reimburse one hundred
30 percent (100%) of the grant; or

31 (2) If the grantee fails to meet the conditions in the second
32 year after the grant award, the grantee may be required to reimburse sixty-six
33 percent (66%) of the grant; or

34 (3) If the grantee fails to meet the conditions in the third year
35 after the grant award, the grantee may be required to reimburse thirty-three
36 percent (33%) of the grant.
