## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-30-404 TO FURTHER  
CLARIFY THOSE INMATES WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR WORK-STUDY  
RELEASE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-30-404  
TO FURTHER CLARIFY THOSE INMATES WHO ARE  
ELIGIBLE FOR WORK-STUDY RELEASE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-30-404 is amended to read as follows:  
12-30-404. Inmates excepted from program.

(a) No person convicted of a capital offense, murder in the first degree, § 5-10-102, rape, § 5-14-103, or kidnapping, § 5-11-102, or a person convicted for the second or subsequent time of aggravated robbery, § 5-12-103, shall be allowed to participate in any work-release program conducted by or for the Department of Correction, or any work-study program or any other type of work program unless the program is conducted at a Department of Correction facility.

(b) However, this section shall not apply to persons participating in work-release programs on July 20, 1979.
