## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 16-21-137 TO REDESIGNATE  
THE FIFTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT AS A DIVISION B  
JUDICIAL DISTRICT AS IT RELATES TO PROSECUTING  
ATTORNEYS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO REDESIGNATE THE FIFTEENTH  
JUDICIAL DISTRICT AS A DIVISION B  
JUDICIAL DISTRICT AS IT RELATES TO  
PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-21-137 is amended to read as follows:  
16-21-137. The Fifteenth Judicial District.

The Fifteenth Judicial District shall be a Division A B Judicial  
District.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the Eighty-  
third General Assembly that the Fifteenth Judicial District would operate more  
effectively with a Class B prosecutor in that it is no longer necessary for  
the Prosecuting Attorney to continue as a full time prosecutor. Therefore, an  
emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for  
the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective  
on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved  
nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the

1 period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is  
2 vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective  
3 on the date the last house overrides the veto.
