SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP — PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT SYSTEM. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: four (4) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and

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SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFERS. A sum not to exceed \$30,102 \$31,935 in the 1999-2000 2001-2002 fiscal year, and \$31,005 \$32,893 in the 2000-01 2002-2003 fiscal year may be transferred from the State Police Retirement Fund to the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System Fund for costs incurred by the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System in administering the State Police Retirement System. Such transfer request shall be made to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and upon his approval, said transfer shall be made on his books and those of the Treasurer of the State and the Auditor of the State. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

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SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE

- 1 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD.
- 2 The remaining balance as of June 30, 2000 June 30, 2002, of unexpended

- 35 <u>appropriations as provided in this Act, the a</u>gency disbursing officer shall
- 36 <u>monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly</u>

- 1 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to

- 16 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
- 17 depletion of the fund balance.
- 18 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
- 19 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
- 20 prior review by the Legislative Council.

- 22 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 23 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 24 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 25 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
- 26 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
- 27 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of
- 28 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
- 29 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
- 30 with in disbursement of said funds.

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- 32 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 33 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 34 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 35 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

1	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
2	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
3	Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
4	
5	SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
6	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
7	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
8	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
9	agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
10	event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
11	of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
12	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
13	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
14	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
15	force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
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
