        SECTION 7. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
     SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all

     appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
22
     monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
23
     basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
24
     less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the
25
     disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.

     Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency
27
     head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the

     State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall

     provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall

     include the following:

     1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
     expenditures on the fund balance.

     2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or

- 5 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought

SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

15 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

16 with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
