19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-65-111(b) is amended to read as follows:

22 (b) Any person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or is found
23 guilty of violating § 5-65-103 or any other equivalent penal law of another
24 state or foreign jurisdiction shall be imprisoned or shall be ordered to
25 perform public service in lieu of jail as follows:

26 (1) For no fewer than seven (7) days and no more than one (1)
27 year for the second offense occurring within five (5) years of the first
28 offense or no fewer than thirty (30) days of community service; and

29 ~~(2) For no fewer than ninety (90) days and no more than one (1)~~
30 ~~year for the third offense occurring within five (5) years of the first~~
31 ~~offense or no fewer than ninety (90) days of community service; and~~

32 ~~(3)~~ (2) For at least one (1) year but no more than six (6) years
33 for the ~~fourth~~ third or subsequent offense occurring within five (5) years of
34 the first offense or not less than one (1) year of community service and shall
35 be guilty of a felony.
