17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 20-7-109, regarding the authority of the State
20 Board of Health, is amended by adding the following additional section:

21 (d)(1) The State Board of Health shall not regulate or prohibit smoking
22 in eating establishments:

23 (A) With seating capacity for fewer than twenty-five (25)
24 people; or

25 (B) If any required modifications would not be readily
26 achievable.

27 (2) As used in this section:

28 (A) "Eating establishment" means any public or private
29 place which is kept, used, maintained, advertised, and held out to the public
30 or to a private or restricted membership as a place where complete meals are
31 actually and regularly served; and

32 (B) "Readily achievable" means easily accomplishable and
33 able to be carried out without much difficulty or expense and able to be
34 carried out without creating a negative financial impact.
