Arkansas Code 24-10-612 is amended to read as follows: 24 24-10-612. Redetermination of benefits. 25 Beginning with the July 1 which is at least twelve (12) full months 26 after the effective date of a monthly benefit, the amount of the benefit shall 27 be redetermined effective each July 1, and the redetermined amount shall be 28 payable for the ensuing year. 29 (b) The redetermined amount shall be the amount of the benefit otherwise payable as of the immediately preceding June 30 multiplied by the 30 following percent: one hundred percent (100%), plus three percent (3%) for 31 32 each full year, but excluding any fraction of a year, in the period from the effective date of the benefit to the current July 1. 33 (c) For purposes of this section, "the amount of the benefit otherwise 34 payable" means the monthly amount of benefit which would be payable 35 36 disregarding the provisions redetermining benefit amounts after retirement.

2	SECTION 2. [THE ARKANSAS CODE REVISION COMMISSION IS NOT REQUIRED TO
3	CODIFY THIS SECTION.] <u>No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall</u>
4	be implemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement system's
5	unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year
6	amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be
7	implemented by any publicly supported system which has unfunded actuarial
8	accrued liabilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years
9	until the unfunded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than
10	the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code, Title 24.
11	
12	SECTION 3. Emergency. It is found and determined by the Eighty-Third
13	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Local police officers and
14	<u>firefighters</u> offer police and fire protection services to the citizens of the
15	State of Arkansas; that a retirement benefit is one of the primary means of
16	compensating these brave and selfless public servants for their services to
17	their local communities; that increasing the annuity rate for LOPFI members to
18	reduce the impact of inflation on their benefits is extremely important in
19	repaying them for their services; and it is administratively necessary to
20	implement this benefit change at the beginning of the state's fiscal year.
21	Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately
22	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall
23	become effective on July 1, 2001.
