Smith 6 7 For An Act To Be Entitled 8 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 24-11-211 TO ALLOW 9 POLICE OFFICERS RETIRING UNDER THE DROP PLAN FOR 10 11 POLICE PENSION AND RELIEF FUNDS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 12 POLICE PENSION SUPPLEMENT PROGRAM; TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 24-11-434 TO REQUIRE THE DEPOSIT OF PENSION 13 SUPPLEMENT PAYMENTS INTO THE RETIRED OFFICERS DROP 14 15 ACCOUNT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. 16 **Subtitle** 17 TO ALLOW POLICE OFFICERS RETIRING UNDER 18 19 THE DROP PLAN TO PARTICIPATE IN THE POLICE PENSION SUPPLEMENT PROGRAM AND 20 21 DEPOSIT PAYMENTS INTO THE DROP ACCOUNTS. 22 23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 24 25 26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 24-11-211(a), concerning participation in the Policemen's Pension Supplement Program, is amended to read as follows: 27 (a) There is hereby created the Arkansas Policemen's Pension Supplement 28 29 Program to be administered by the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board. Local and municipal police officers provide valuable services to the 30 31 citizens of this state by risking their lives and health to protect the lives 32 and property of our citizens. Upon their retirement or participation in a DROP 33 plan from active service, these police officers are provided retirement benefits through local police pension funds. These retired police officers and 34 35 their survivors, if deceased, are expected to pay for all kinds of expenses 36 after their retirement, some which are unexpected and can be extremely

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1	expensive. A program by which the state can provide a modest annual supplement
2	to retirement benefits to defray unexpected expenses for retired police
3	officers and their survivors will benefit all local police officers, local
4	governments, and all citizens of the state. As used in this section, the term
5	"retired police officers" shall include police officers who are retired from
6	active service and officers who remain actively employed while participating
7	in the Police Officers' Deferred Option Plan under a policemen's pension and
8	relief fund.
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10	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 24-11-434(d)(3), concerning the payments into a
11	Police Officers' Deferred Option Plan account, is amended to read as follows:
12	(3) The monthly retirement benefits that would have been payable
13	had the member elected to cease employment and receive a service retirement
14	and pension supplement payments made by the Policemen's Pension Supplement
15	<u>Program</u> shall be paid into the Arkansas Police Officers' Deferred Option Plan
16	account.
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18	SECTION 3. [THE ARKANSAS CODE REVISION COMMISSION IS NOT REQUIRED TO
19	CODIFY THIS SECTION.] No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be
20	$\underline{\text{implemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement system's}}$
21	unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year
22	amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be
23	implemented by any publicly supported system which has unfunded actuarial
24	accrued liabilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years
25	until the unfunded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than
26	the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code, Title 24.
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
