

25	<u>(a)</u> There is est	ablished an official state tartan	to be known as "The	
26	<u>Natural State Tartan".</u>			
27	<u>(b)</u> The colors p	resent in the tartan shall be made	e up of:	
28	<u>(1) A gree</u>	n background to represent the Natu	ural State;	
29	<u>(2)</u> Stripe	s of red to represent the original	settlers;	
30	<u>(3)</u> Stripe	s of white to represent diamonds;	and

7	SECTION 3. <u>Arkansas Traveler Tartan.</u>		
8	<u>(a) There is established an official state tartan to be known as the</u>		
9	"Arkansas Travel er Tartan".		
10	(b) The colors present in the tartan design represent the State of		
11	Arkansas in the following ways:		
12	(1) Green for the beautiful forests and trees of the Ozark		
13	Mountains where many of the Scottish immigrants settled;		
14	(2) Blue for Arkansas' beautiful lakes, rivers, and streams;		
15	(3) Yellow for the bright rays of sunshine during the spring and		
16	summer seasons; and		
17	(4) Red for the blood of our strong family ties to Scotland and		
18	within the State of Arkansas.		
19	<u>(c) The Arkansas Traveler Tartan was designed and woven by Jason Emory</u>		
20	<u>Nickerson, a resident of Hot Springs, Arkansas.</u>		
21	(d) The Arkansas Traveler Tartan shall be described by the following		
22	thread count:		
23	(1) Yellow, two (2) thread count;		
24	(2) Green, thirty-six (36) thread count;		
25	(3) Red, ten (10) thread count;		
26	(4) Yellow, eighteen (18) thread count;		
27	(5) Green, twelve (12) thread count;		
28	(6) Blue, sixteen (16) thread count;		
29	(7) Green, eight (8) thread count;		
30	(8) Blue, ten (10) thread count; and		
31	<u>(9) Green, eighteen (18) thread count.</u>

33	SECTION 4. <u>Tartan Day.</u>		
34	April 6 of every year shall be designated as "Tartan Day" to honor		
35	<u>Arkansans of Scottish descent.</u>
