The balance of the appropriation made in Section 4 and 7 Section 5 herein which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 8 <u>2000</u> <u>2002</u>, may be carried forward and used for the same purpose in the fiscal 9 year ending June 30, <u>2001</u> <u>2003</u>. <u>The provisions of this section shall be in</u> 10 effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

12 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL. LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING 13 14 REQUIREMENTS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall annually file with 15 the Arkansas Legislative Council and the Joint Committee on Advanced 16 Communications and Information Technology a report summarizing all 17 expenditures made under the provisions of Section 4 of this Act. The 18 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through 19 June 30, 2003.

21 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 22 CARRY 23 FORWARD. At the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000 2002, the 24 Department of Information Systems may certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of 25 the State an unexpended amount of appropriation, as provided for in 26 Telecommunications/Technology Delivery in Section 3 of this Act, which may be 27 transferred forward for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001 2003, for the 28 sole purpose of providing payments for the telecommunication system. The 29 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through 30 June 30, 2003.

32 <u>SECTION 15. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED</u> 33 <u>SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.</u> FUND BALANCES. (A) For all 34 <u>appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall</u> 35 <u>monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly</u> 36 <u>basis. 1 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the 2 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. 3 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency 4 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall 5 6 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall 7 include the following: 8 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such 9 expenditures on the fund balance. 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or 10 11 any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance. 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs 12 13 or one-time purchase of capitalized items. 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not 14 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent 15 16 depletion of the fund balance. 17 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and 18 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought 19 prior review by the Legislative Council. 20 21 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 24 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary 25 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures 26 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 27 28 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 29 with in disbursement of said funds. 30 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 31 32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 34 35 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

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4	SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
5	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
6	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
7	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
8	agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
9	event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
10	of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
11	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
12	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
13	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
14	force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
