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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
25 State Highway and Transportation Department for the biennial period ending
26 June 30, ~~2001~~ 2003, the following maximum number of regular employees and the
27 maximum annual salary for such employees; and no greater salary than that
28 established herein shall be paid to any employee from appropriations
29 hereinafter made for said department, ~~except the maximum salaries herein~~
30 ~~authorized may be exceeded by the salaries for the twenty-seventh pay period~~
31 ~~for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000~~. The annual salaries to be paid to
32 each employee authorized herein shall be determined by the Arkansas Highway
33 Commission within the limitations as set out in this Section and the funds and
34 the appropriations made available for such purposes. All positions established
35 herein shall be exempt from the provisions of the Uniform Personnel
36 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its

1 successor, but shall not be exempt from the provisions of the Regular Salaries
 2 Procedures and Restrictions Act . Provided further that the salaries for the
 3 pay periods beginning ~~July 1, 1999~~ June 27, 2002 and ~~June 22, 2000~~ June 26,
 4 2003 can be paid from the salaries and overtime authorized for the fiscal
 5 years ending June 30, ~~2000~~ 2003 and June 30, ~~2001~~ 2004 respectively.

SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME. The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to pay overtime to its employees, and the administration thereof shall be in accordance with the

The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to reimburse from funds appropriated in Item (4) of Section 2 of this Act, State Highway and Transportation Department employees for personal liability insurance premiums paid by State Highway and Transportation Department employees for liability coverage on state owned vehicles of the Highway and Transportation Department up to a maximum of Fifty Dollars (\$50) per annum per employee, at the option of the eligible employee.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is authorized to pay from Item (3) of Section 2 hereof, the Unemployment Premiums and Workers Compensation Premiums, at a rate not in excess of the Agency's experience rate, under the provisions of regulations established by the Department of Finance and Administration.

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The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to take appropriate action as necessary to restrict or reduce the operating, administration, and other associated costs of the State Highway and Transportation Department, including the Arkansas Highway Police Division, for the biennial period ending June 30, ~~2001~~ 2003. Provided further, that the Arkansas Highway Commission is directed to furnish the Arkansas Legislative Council with an expenditure status report regarding the financial activities of the State Highway and Transportation Department at least quarterly, beginning no later than September 30, 1989.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
2 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
5 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
6 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
7 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
8 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
9 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
10 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
11 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
12 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
13 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
14 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
