17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-1-109(b), concerning periods of limitation on
20 criminal offenses, is amended to read as follows:

21 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, prosecutions for
22 other offenses must be commenced within the following periods of limitation
23 after their commission:

24 (1) Class Y and Class A felonies, six (6) years, except rape for
25 which the period of limitation may be extended to fifteen (15) years during
26 which extended time a prosecution for rape may be commenced if based upon
27 forensic DNA testing or other tests which may become available through
28 advances in technology;

29 (2) Class B, C, or D, or unclassified felonies, three (3) years;

30 (3) Misdemeanors or violations, one (1) year.
