19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-21-609 is amended to read as follows:

22 6-21-609. Prohibition against smoking or use of tobacco or tobacco
23 products - Exception.

24 (a) ~~Smoking~~ Except as provided in subsection (b), smoking or use of
25 tobacco or products containing tobacco in any form in or on any property owned
26 or leased by a public school district, including school buses, is prohibited.

27 (b) The board of directors of each public school district of this state
28 may designate one (1) or more areas on school property in which area smoking
29 will be permitted.

30 ~~(b)(c)~~ (c) A copy of this statute shall be posted in a conspicuous location
31 at every entrance to each building owned or leased by a public school district
32 and every school bus used to transport public school students.

33 ~~(c)(d)~~ (d) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be
34 guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a
35 fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than one hundred dollars
36 (\$100).
