    set a maximum number of racing passes to be printed and issued annually and

(b)(1) Racing passes provided to and accepted by members of the
General Assembly and constitutional officers are to be distributed by them to
their constituents in order to provide for a statewide distribution of the
racing passes and to persons residing outside the state of Arkansas in order
to promote tourism and advance the economic interests of the state.
(2) The passes provided to the members of the General Assembly
