Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 1, Chapter 4, Subchapter 1 is amended by adding an additional section to read as follows:

1-4-124. State Scottish Tartan.
(a) The Scottish immigrants have greatly contributed to the culture, customs, music, and dance native to the State of Arkansas; therefore, it is
appropriate that we honor them by adopting the official Arkansas State
Scottish Tartan.
(b) The colors present in the tartan design represent the State of Arkansas in the following ways:
(1) Green for the beautiful forests and trees of the Ozark Mountains where many of the Scottish immigrants settled;
(2) Blue for Arkansas' beautiful lakes, rivers, and streams;
(3) Yellow for the bright rays of sunshine during the spring and

summer seasons; and

    (4) Red for the blood of our strong family ties to scotland and
    within the State of Arkansas.
(c) This tartan was designed and woven by dason Emory Nickerson, a
resident of Hot Springs, Arkansas.
(d) The official Arkansas Scottish Tartan shall be described by the following threadcount:
(1) Yellow, two (2) threadcount;
(2) Green, thirty-six (36) threadcount;
(3) Red, ten (10) threadcount;
(4) Yellow, eighteen (18) threadcount;
(5) Green, twelve (12) threadcount;
(6) Blue, sixteen (16) threadcount;
(7) Green, eight (8) threadcount;
(8) Blue, ten (10) threadcount; and
(9) Green, eighteen (18) threadcount.
