Arkansas Code 27-14-1206(b) pertaining to the registration 23 24 of trailers is amended to read as follows: 25 (b) Forty-five (45) Thirty (30) days before the expiration of the 26 license, the director shall notify the owner of a registered trailer subject to this subchapter at the last address of the owner of the trailer as the 27 owner's name and address appear on the records of the office, but the director 28 29 is not required to go beyond the face of the last registration statement. 30 31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-14-1210(a) pertaining to the registration of trailers is amended to read as follows: 32 (a) The owner of every trailer of a type subject to the provisions of 33 this subchapter, upon registration, shall receive a permanent license plate 34 35 issued by the director upon the payment of a biennial triennial fee based upon 36 the annual fee as set forth in § 27-14-601.

2	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 27-14-1214(b) pertaining to the registration
3	of trailers is amended to read as follows:
4	(b) The applicant, upon receiving notification by the director of his
5	new permanent registration date, shall, within the time prescribed by the
6	director, pay a twelve month thirty-six-month registration fee.
7	
8	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 27-14-1215 pertaining to the registration of
9	trailers is amended to read as follows:
10	27-14-1215. Issuance of biennial <u>triennial</u> tab.
11	(a) In conjunction with the permanent license plate, the director shall
12	issue a tab or decal biennially <u>triennially</u> , or when appropriate, to each
13	qualified applicant as evidence of the biennial <u>triennial</u> payment of license
14	fees.
15	(b) The trailer owner shall affix and display the tab or decal in such
16	place as the director shall designate.
