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SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-14-1205 is repealed.

1 27-14-1205. Registration on monthly basis.

(a) The director shall establish a system of registration on a monthly series basis to distribute the work of registering trailers as uniformly as practicable throughout the twelve (12) months of the calendar year.

- (b) The director may set the number of renewal periods within the month from one (1) each month to one (1) each day of the month depending on which system is most economical and best accommodates the public.
- (c) The director shall, upon request, assign to any owner of two (2) or more trailers the same registration period.
- (d) Registration shall be valid for three (3) years from the date thereof and shall continue for three-year periods thereafter, as long as renewed every three (3) years within the time required by law.

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 27-14-1206, concerning the time and place for registration or renewal of trailers, is amended to read as follows:
  - 27-14-1206. Time and place for registration or renewal.
- (a) An applicant may apply, in person or by mail, for the issuance of permanent license plates or renewal of license to the revenue collector in the county where he resides or to the director.
- (b) Forty-five (45) Thirty (30) days before the expiration of the a license issued prior to January 1, 2002, the director shall notify the owner of a registered trailer subject to this subchapter at the last address of the owner of the trailer as the owner's name and address appear on the records of the office, but the director is not required to go beyond the face of the last registration statement.
- (c)(1) A proper application for registration or renewal <u>of a</u> registration issued prior to January 1, 2002 by mail must be postmarked not later than fifteen (15) days before the date for renewal to allow time for processing.
- (2) The director is authorized to impose a first class postage fee for handling the issuance of all new licenses or renewals by mail.

- SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 27-14-1210(a) is amended to read as follows:
- (a) The owner of every trailer of a type subject to the provisions of this subchapter, upon registration, shall receive a permanent license plate issued by the director upon the payment of a biennial fee based upon the

annual fee as the fee set forth in § 27-14-601.

SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 27-14-1211(a) is amended to read as follows:

(a) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration is authorized to issue to the owner of a trailer subject to this subchapter a permanent license plate, subject to replacement at the request of the owner because of theft, loss, wear, or mutilation, or at the discretion of either the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police or the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration upon payment of the fee set forth in

§ 27-14-601.

11 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code 27-14-1213(a) is amended to read as follows:

(a) The director shall mail application forms for all renewals of registration under this subchapter <u>issued prior to January 1, 2002</u> to the last address of the owner of the trailer as the owner's name and address appear on the records of the office.

- SECTION 7. Arkansas Code 27-14-1214 is amended to read as follows: 27-14-1214. Renewal of registration.
- (a) The owner of any permanent license plate issued by the director prior to January 1, 2002 may renew his registration, in person or by mail, at a county revenue office or with the director during any day from forty-five (45) thirty (30) days prior to the date on which his registration shall expire.
- (b) The applicant, upon receiving notification by the director of his new permanent registration date, shall, within the time prescribed by the director, pay a twelve month registration fee the fee set forth in § 27-14-601.

- SECTION 8. Arkansas Code 27-14-1215(a) is amended to read as follows:
- (a) In conjunction with the permanent license plate, the director shall may issue a tab or decal biennially, or when appropriate, to each qualified applicant as evidence of the biennial payment of license fees.

SECTION 9. Arkansas Code 27-14-1216(b) is amended to read as follows: (b)(1) The owner shall remove the license plate and any plate sticker,

1	metal tab, or decal therefrom and forward them to the office.		
2	(2) He may have such plate and plate sticker, metal tab, or		
3	decal, and the registration number thereon, assigned to another trailer, upor		
4	payment of the fees required by law and subject to the rules and regulations		
5	of the office.		
6	(3) The owner shall pay a transfer fee of one dollar (\$1.00).		
7	However, if the fee for registration and licensing the trailer to be		
8	registered is greater than the registration fee paid for the trailer		
9	originally licensed, then the office shall, in addition, collect an amount		
10	equal to the excess payable for the trailer to be registered.
