Arkansas Code 27-53-202, concerning accident reports, is 24 25 amended to read as follows: (b)(1) In addition to the requirements of subsection (a) of this 26 27 section, the driver of any taxicab, motor bus, or other motor vehicle carrying passengers for hire involved in an accident resulting in injury to or death of 28 29 any person shall notify the nearest law enforcement agency immediately. The drivers of any taxicab, motor bus, or other motor vehicle carrying passengers 30 31 for hire shall make themselves readily available to the investigating agency's office or officers. 32 (2) The accident report shall contain a full and complete list of 33 the names and addresses of all passengers occupying the taxicab, bus, or other 34 35 vehicle at the time of the accident. 36 (3) The report shall include provisions which inquire about

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1	whether or not the accident was caused as a result of the driver's lapse of
2	consciousness, epileptic condition, or similar nervous disorder, or an episode
3	of marked mental confusion or as a result of any physical disability, disease,
4	or disorder or any other medical condition of the driver affecting the
5	vehicle's safe operation.
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7	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-53-206(a), concerning accident reports, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	(a)(1) The Department of Arkansas State Police shall prepare and upon
10	request supply to police departments, coroners, sheriffs, and other suitable
11	agencies or individuals forms for accident reports required under this
12	subchapter.
13	(2) (A) The reports shall call for sufficiently detailed
14	information to disclose with reference to a traffic accident the cause,
15	conditions then existing, and the persons and vehicles involved.
16	(B) Every accident report shall include provisions which
17	inquire about whether or not the accident was caused as a result of the
18	driver's lapse of consciousness, epileptic condition, or similar nervous
19	disorder, or an episode of marked mental confusion or as a result of any
20	physical disability, disease, or disorder or any other medical condition of
21	the driver.
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
